

the juice on berry

Opulent shades of rich, ripe fruitiness to keep you warm all winter long

Shades of berry are spreading like jam on hot toast this winter. Why? Inviting, rich and succulent, these fruity hues are perfect for bringing warmth to pale rooms. You'll love this season's mouth-watering, plummy purples and claret reds, through to the muted, soft hues of mauves and pinks.

It's a warm and cosy choice for a feature wall or a room that doesn't get much sun, like a dining room or hallway. Alternatively, give a neutral room a lift with some lush berry accessories – opulent velvet or brocade cushions with a matching throw draped over your favourite chair.

After a contemporary look? Try teaming dusty berries with charcoal greys. This combo also works well in bedlinen. Other colours that work best with berries: dusty apricot, aqua, and a dash of chartreuse. Or, for a more oriental flavour, think raw silks and throw the deeper berries in with a mix of red, orange and yellow. Simply delicious! >

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
